



Horncastle & District Tennis Club Court Booking Policy



Horncastle and District Tennis Club Ltd wants everyone to be able to have access to all our courts in an affordable and orderly manner to ensure maximum enjoyment and access to our sport. We recognise that membership of the club is not a desirable option for everyone and therefore all the courts are available to book by non-members.

Bookings take precedence over people turning up on-spec without a booking.

Regular activities/matches/coaching sessions will be pre booked in advance and take precedence over other bookings but there are very few times when no courts are available for public use.

Parents are reminded that if they book courts for their children, they take full responsibility for them. Children under 12 should not be left unsupervised at the courts.

An App is available for phone usage too.

A code for the court padlock, along with directions and are automatically emailed to each booking.

The access options are as follows:

Membership of the club includes free use of the courts. (There is a £6 per hour, per court charge for floodlights)

Mini membership (U10 years old) gives free use of the courts for the child and the parent/guardian while they are playing with the child.

Members may bring a guest to the courts for a £5 fee payable when booking the court.

Courts can be booked up to 2 weeks in advance.

Members can request a regular booking which will be booked in advance for them.

Non Members

Guests can book and pay for a court online at £8 per hour. Floodlights are an additional £6 per hour

An App is available for phone usage too.

A code for the court padlock, along with directions and instructions are automatically emailed to each booking. . If floodlights are booked, a contact number is requested and the booking is advised that we need 24 hours notice to arrange for you

Courts can be booked up to 2 weeks in advance.

Names of participants must be filled in on booking.
